The pity of it is that so few authentic pieces of historic glass have come down to us. Fragility is a poor barrier to the ravages of time. But it is fortunate that at Steuben Furnaces the craft practices are identical with the best historic periods. A seething pot of molten glass, a blasting hot furnace, a slender blow tube . . . . . these are the implements.

The rest is skill and a love of beauty and a striving for perfection that is as honest in its purpose as the crystalline brilliance of Steuben Glass itself.








